Cameron “Cam” Pike of Cold Lake, Alberta, passed away on August 13, 2025, after a brief battle with cancer. Born in Montreal, Quebec, Cam lived life with energy, humor, and an unstoppable love for family, friends, and the things he cherished most. 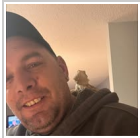
