Robert Dana Waldhoff passed away suddenly at the University of Alberta hospital in Edmonton, Alberta on March 16, 2025 at the age of 66 years. Rob was born in Burnaby, B.C. on July 21, 1958 and grew up in Sechelt B.C. until he was 12 years old. It was in Sechelt that his younger brothers Troy and Shannon were born. From there the family moved to Edmonton, Alberta and eventually to St. Albert when Rob was 16 and remained there until the boys were adults.

Growing up Rob was interested in track and field and he excelled at long distance running. He also took boxing lessons in his teenage years. He enjoyed staying active. His brother Troy describes him as ambitious and outgoing growing up. As an older brother he also looked out for his younger brothers, spending time with them and they were close throughout their childhood.

The simple pleasures in life and the great outdoors brought Rob great joy. He enjoyed camping, fishing and hunting as he got older. His passion for hunting and fishing started as a teen and he became an avid fisherman in his adult life.

Rob was a man who wore many hats over his professional career which included employment as a camp cook in Fort McMurray, a heavy duty tire service man with Kal-Tire, a concrete/construction estimator for his own company and in his later years, he excelled as a heavy equipment salesman with Bobcat and Kubota.

Rob is lovingly remembered by his brother Troy (Laura), son Mike (Vanessa), daughter Ashley, stepsons: Vincent, Mark (Biannca) and Josh as well as his nieces: Chelsea, Nicki, Natalie, Amanda, Sherri-Lynn, Billi Jo, and Shawna, his nephew Jeff, his grandchildren and his extended family and friends.
